

Volunteer Docents at the Fairfield Museum

Are you a lifelong learner with a passion for sharing history with your community? The Fairfield Museum is recruiting a new class of docents, trained volunteer educators, who present guided tours and education programs for K-12 students. The docent program is both intellectually stimulating and socially rewarding and includes courses, readings, and discussions on topics in American History. Whether you've lived in Fairfield for many years or you are new to the area, discover the rewards of sharing the rich history of our town with visitors of all ages.

Who Can Apply?

Volunteer Docents should have experience in:

- Working with children in K-12 settings or delivering tours and educational programs.
- Volunteer Docents are not required to live in Fairfield, but you must have a reliable means of transportation to and from the Fairfield Museum for training, meetings, and volunteer shifts.

What skills do I need?

Volunteer Docents should have:

- A love of history and learning;
- Good communication and public speaking skills;
- Good listening skills;
- Flexibility/adaptability;
- Tolerance and respect for others.

What is the commitment?

- Attend required volunteer training sessions & quarterly meetings.
- Successfully complete a practice tour.
- Be able to walk and stand for the length of tours, up to 1.5 hours. Please note that some historical buildings are not handicap accessible.
- Read and study materials on history and education.
- Commit to at least 2 volunteer shifts per month. Shifts for K-12 programs are Mondays through Fridays from 9 am and 1 pm or from 4 and 5:30 pm. Shifts for tours at the c. 1750 Ogden House are Sundays between June and September from 1 to 4 pm. Note that volunteer Docents should plan to arrive about 15 minutes prior to the start of their shift.

How to Apply

Individuals interested in applying to become a volunteer Docent should fill out an application and submit it along with all supplemental materials. Priority will be given to applications submitted by **May 5, 2025**.
